Tweed River Lantern Festival

Saturday 31 October

These lanterns will be carried by our students at the Lantern Parade on Saturday 31 October at Budd Park Murwillumbah. All students, parents and friends from Tyalgum School are welcome to join Tyalgum School in the parade holding up the lanterns we had made at the workshop. The parade will start at the council building at Tumbulgum Road, walk down Commercial Road, over the bridge, through Budd Park and back under the bridge to finish at the car park in the corner of River Drive and Prospero Street. Students, parents and friends who will be walking in the parade are to assemble at the starting point at 7.15pm. Lanterns will be distributed at this location and the parade will begin at 8.00pm.

Murwillumbah Show

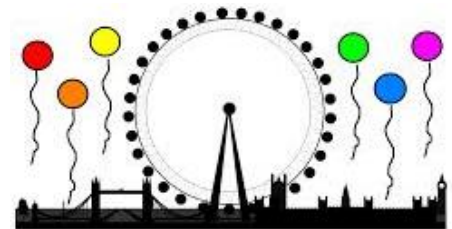
Friday 6 November

excursion, so there will be no cost. There will be no supervision at school.

A bus has been booked to leave Tyalgum School at 9.00am sharp so we can get to watch and cheer for our school relay team. Students will then walk around to view all the show exhibitions, especially our school display. Students will need to bring from home food for morning tea and lunch, drink bottle and hat. Purchasing of food or merchandise at the show ***will not*** be allowed. Therefore it is not necessary to bring money. If you wish to pick up your child from the show, please submit a written note to school before the day of excursion.



The bus will return to the showground around 12.00 and 12.30pm to take our students to the Tweed Regional Art Gallery. Students will have lunch in the grass area outside the gallery and then view the Les Peterkin Portrait Prize display. Student will be back at school for the end of day.

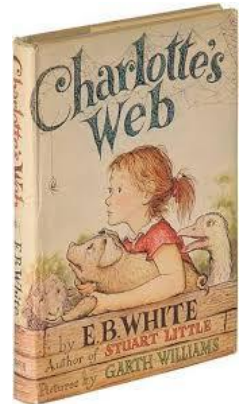

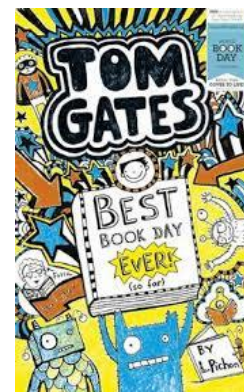
Bonnie - Charlotte's Web
