Here at Tyalgum PS we work hard to keep everyone safe. Tyalgum PS has a reviewed and updated Emergency Management Plan which also includes bushfire response. All families are advised to have their own emergency plans in place, to talk about them, and to ensure that the children know what they are. Our students are encouraged to know family phone numbers, and also to know that they have a trusted person to stay with in the event that they cannot get home. Most of our families have already planned for this, but if it hasn't occurred to you before, it is definitely a family conversation worth having.

The Rural Fire Service has lots of useful information on their website, [www.rfs.nsw.gov.au](http://www.rfs.nsw.gov.au), including printable survival plans which can be downloaded. They also have an app called "Fires Near Me", which has relevant and useful live time information, and can be downloaded to your phone.

Our lovely School Counsellor, Louise Stanley, will be running another series of workshops this term. These workshops focus on friendships and this term the target group is Year 3 and 4 boys.

The Police Youth Liason Officer, Mark Harrison, will visit our school next week to talk to parents and students about cyber safety. This talk is targeted at our Year 5 and 6 students, but all parents are encouraged to come along and listen in. There will be time for questions at the end. The talk will begin at 9.30am Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> November.

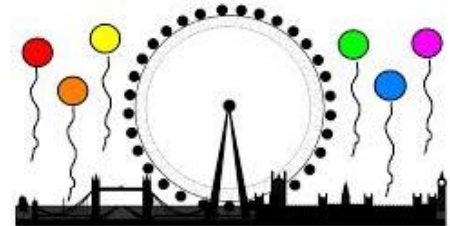
