### Friday 6 November

Tyalgum School students will be participating in an excursion to the Murwillumbah Show and Tweed Regional Art Gallery on Friday 6 November. ***This is a whole school, Kinder to Year 6 excursion***, so there will be no cost. There will be no supervision at school.



A bus has been booked to leave Tyalgum School at 9.00am sharp so we can get to watch and cheer for our school relay team. Students will then walk around to view all the show exhibitions, especially our school display. Students will need to bring from home food for morning tea and lunch, drink bottle and hat. Purchasing of food or merchandise at the show ***will not*** be allowed. Therefore it is not necessary to bring money. Students that normally walk or are driven to school, please be sure you are at school by 8.50am for a roll call before boarding the bus for a ***9.00am sharp departure***.
