Department of Education event to pass basic water safety test and must be observed and signed off by an instructor/teacher. These requirements also apply to any water sport like canoeing, kayaking etc.

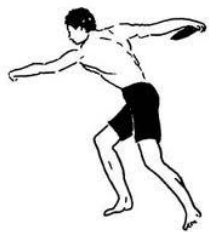
