## Dear Parents and Friends,

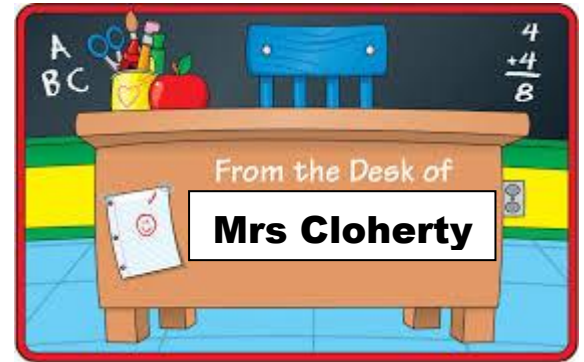

## Possible support for Farmers to restore their fencing

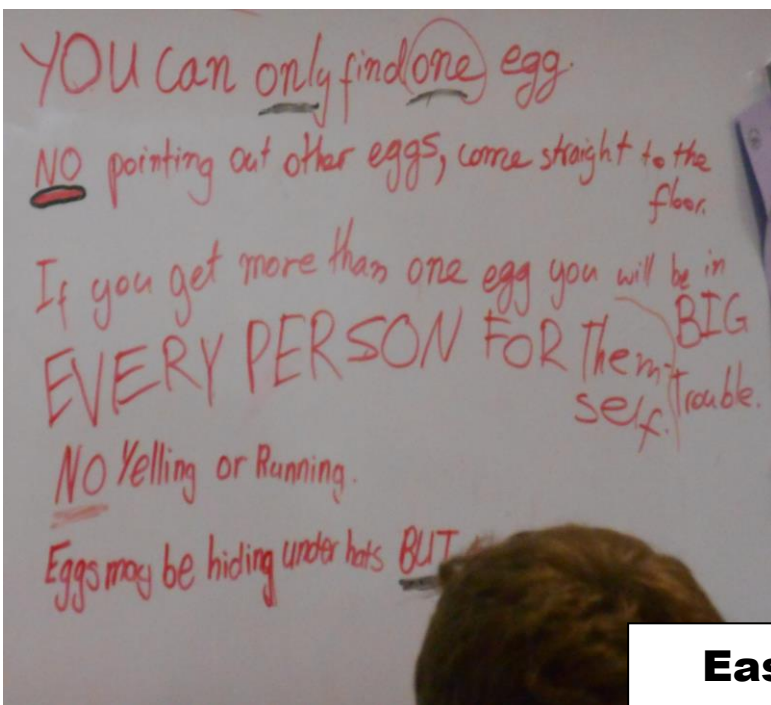
Commercial Farmers needing help with restoring their fencing after the flood can register their need with Eli Szandala at Tweed Shire Council on 66702599.
