On **Thursday the 10th of August** we will be holding our annual **Book Fair and Book character parade**. The Book Fair will be held

Students will have the opportunity to complete their wish lists in the week leading up to the Book Fair. The wish lists will allow you to see the cost of your child's preferred books. Students have been reminded that parents are under no obligation to purchase books from their wish lists. A percentage of the profits from all sales returns to the school library, allowing us to purchase exciting new books for the school. The book character parade will begin at 9:15am and will take place under the big COLA. Students are encouraged to **come to school dressed as a character from a book they have recently read**. Children will then parade with their class, carrying the book that their character is from.
